(A582 FARINGTON ROAD, FARINGTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

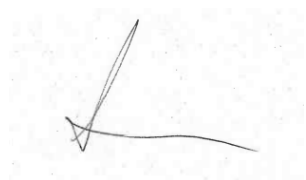
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of A582 Farington Road, Farington (Westbound carriageway only) from its junction with A5083 Stanifield Lane, Lostock Hall for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 2000 hours until 0500 hours on Monday 2nd November 2026 until Friday 6th November 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

A582 Farington Road - A582 Flensburg Way - A582 Penwortham Way
- A582 Golden Way - A582 Guild Way – A59 Guild Way – A59 Marsh Lane – A59 Ring Way – A6 Ring Way – A6 Stanley Street – A6 London Road – A6 Victoria Road – A6 London Way - A582 Lostock Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow major ground level works to be carried out.
