(BACK LANE, MAWDESLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back Lane, Mawdesley from its junction with Gorsey Lane, Mawdesley to its junction with Old Lane, Mawdesley.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 23rd November 2026 until 1600 hours on Friday 27th November 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Back Lane – Maltkiln Lane – Chorley Road – Bentley Lane – Ridley Lane – Bradshaw Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new connection works to be carried out.
