(WILLOW ROAD, ULNES WALTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. Willow Road, Ulnes Walton from its junction with Moss Lane, Ulnes Walton for a distance of 167 metres in a westerly direction.
 - II. Willow Road, Ulnes Walton from its junction with Wray Crescent, Ulnes Walton for a distance of 108 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibitions will be operative daily on the following dates and times;
 - I. From 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Monday 12th October 2026 until Wednesday 14th October 2026.
 - II. From 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Thursday 15th October 2026 until Friday 16th October 2026.

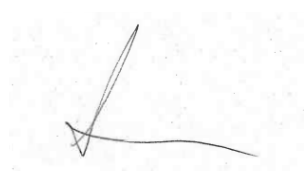
Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.

4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Willow Road – Wray Crescent and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to support with hoarding installation works at Garth and Wymott project.
