(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

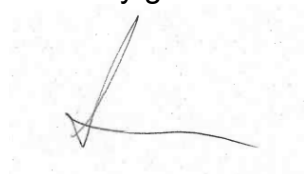
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. Smithy Lane, Much Hoole from its junction with Moss House Lane, Much Hoole to its junction with Town Lane, Much Hoole.
 - II. Town Lane, Much Hoole from its junction with Smithy Lane, Much Hoole to its junction with Liverpool Old Road, Much Hoole.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 12th October 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 27th November 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Smithy Lane – Liverpool Old Road - A59 Liverpool Road – Liverpool Old Road – Town Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out to install and joint cable.
