(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

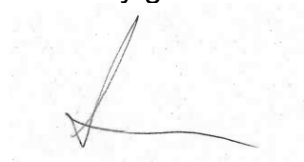
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bentley Lane, Mawdesley from its junction with Bannister Lane, Bispham to its junction with Ridley Lane, Mawdesley.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1600 hours on Thursday 15th October 2026 until Tuesday 20th October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Bentley Lane – Barmskin Lane – Smithy Brow – Toogood Lane – Courage Low Lane – Hill House Fold Lane – Robin Hood Lane – A5209 Hall Lane - A5209 Sparrow Hill - A5209 Parbold Hill - B5246 Lancaster Lane - B5246 Chorley Road – Chorley Road and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway pre-surface dressing patching works to be carried out.
