(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. Bentley Lane, Heskin from its junction with Barmskin Lane, Heskin to its merging with Bentley Lane, Mawdesley.
 - II. Bentley Lane, Mawdesley from its merging with Bentley Lane, Heskin to its junction with Sanderson Lane, Heskin.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on Tuesday 29th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Bentley Lane – Barmskin Lane – Smithy Brow – Toogood Lane – Courage Low Lane – Hill House Fold Lane – Robin Hood Lane – High Moor Lane – Whittle Lane – Bannister Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow overhead cabling works to be carried out.
