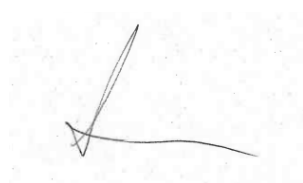
(GREENS LANE, DOWNHOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Greens Lane, Downholland from its junction with B5195 Formby Lane to outside Greens Lane Farm.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Monday 21st September until 1900 hours on Wednesday 7th October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
B5195 Broad Lane, A5147 Delph Lane, A5147 Mairscough Lane,
A5147 Southport Road, Hall Lane, Eager Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow major water mains replacement works to be carried out.
