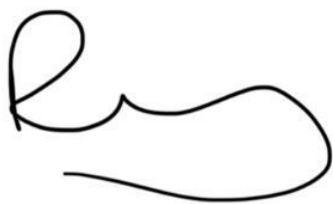
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Nateby Crossing Lane from its junction with Croston Barn Lane for 150 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 18th November 2026 until 1800 hours on Friday 20th November 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Cockerham Road – Preston Lancaster New Road – Longmoor Lane
and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation to install 12m of duct to link existing BT boxes to facilitate spine cabling works to be carried out by JN Civils on behalf of BT.
