(DELPH LANE, BARNACRE, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Delph Lane, Barnacre from outside Forge Cottage to Forge Bridge.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 1st September 2026 until 1800 hours on 2nd September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Parkhead Lane – Butt Hill Lane – Smithy Lane – Stubbins Lane –
Garstang Road – Preston Lancaster Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation to replace frame and cover in the carriageway works to be carried out by JN Civils on behalf of BT.
