(ELMRIDGE LANE, CHIPPING, RIBBLE VALLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Elmridge Lane, Chipping from its junction with Height Lane travelling in a southerly direction to its entrance with Elmridge Farmhouse.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 09:30 hours until 15:30 hours on 26th October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Height Lane – Mill Lane – Hesketh Lane – Chipping Road – Moss Side Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Openreach on behalf of British Telecom to carry out essential works on their assets.
