(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hopwood Street, Preston from its junction with Meadow Street to outside of Attwater & Sons Ltd.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 2200 hours on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2026 until 0600 hours on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

South Meadow Street – East Street – Holstein Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom mast maintenance works to be carried out.
