For example, if opting out of meals, a suitable packed lunch and snacks must be supplied each day. If opting out of consumables, sufficient supplies must be provided for each session attended.

How to Opt Out

Parents wishing to opt out of any optional service should notify me in writing (email or signed written notice). I will confirm the change in writing and discuss any practical arrangements required to ensure the child's needs continue to be met.

A minimum of **four weeks' written notice** is required to start or stop any optional service. This allows enough time to update invoices, purchase arrangements and care plans where necessary.

Parents may change their decision at any time by providing the same four weeks' written notice.
