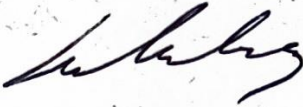
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Lindeth Road, Silverdale from approximately 65 metres south of property known as Gibraltar Cottage for a distance of approximately 50 metres in a south westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 23rd September 2026 until 1700 hours on Thursday 24th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Access will always be available to residents upon request and whenever safe to do so
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
NA - CUL-DE-SAC No diversion available.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow BT Pole replacement works to be carried out.
