(PEAR TREE LANE, EUXTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

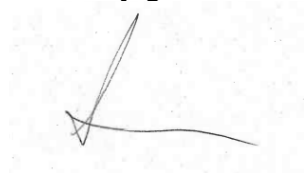
1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Pear Tree Lane, Euxton from its junction with Euxton Lane, Euxton to its junction with School Lane, Euxton.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 5th October 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 11th December 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Pear Tree Lane – Euxton Lane – A49 Wigan Road – School Lane and Vice Versa.

Pear Tree Lane – Euxton Lane – B5252 West Way – Washington Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow drainage installation works to be carried out.
