(STONEY BANK ROAD, EARBY, PENDLE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Stoney Bank Road, Earby from outside number 8 Stoney Bank Road to outside number 22 Stoney Bank Road, Earby.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Tuesday 4th August 2026 until Thursday 6th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Coolham Lane – Bleara Road – West Road – Skipton Old Road –
Castle Road – Skipton Road – Skipton New Road – Colne Road –
Victoria Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow outstanding highway defect to be carried out.
