(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Cambridge Street, Brierfield from outside property number 8 Cambridge Street to outside property number 12 Cambridge Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Monday 17th August 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 21st August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Railway Street – Sackville Street – Oxford Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the excavation of joint bays in the carriageway and footway for approximately 10 metres for 2 new connections. Carried out by Network Plus.
