(SHEEP HOUSE LANE, RIVINGTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Sheep House Lane, Rivington from its boundary with Blackburn with Darwen to its junction with Hall Lane, Rivington.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Friday 18th September 2026 until Wednesday 23rd September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Sheep House Lane – Rivington Lane - Lever Park Avenue - A673 Scholes Bank – Lee Lane – Church Street - B6226 Chorley Old Road - Walker Fold Road - Colliers Row Road - Scout Road - A675 Belmont Road – Rivington Road and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway pre-surface dressing patching works to be carried out.
