PLANTATION STREET, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Plantation Street, Accrington from Abbey Street to Plantation Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force from 0600 hours on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> August to 1800 hours on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibition will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be  
Main diversion: Plantation Street - Abbey Street – Adelaide Street – Sandy Lane – Wensley Drive and vice versa.

Local diversion: Bradford Street – Washington Street – Cedar Street – Park Street – Avenue Parade.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway re surfacing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
