

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(MOSS SIDE LANE, STALMINE-WITH-STAYNALL, WYREBOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Moss Side Lane, Stalmine-With-Staynall from its junction with Crook Dale Lane for 10 metres in either direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1700 hours on Tuesday 24th November 2026 until Monday 7th December 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Union Lane – Back Lane – Clay Gap Lane – Sower Carr Lane – Carr Lane – Stricklands Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation of joint bay with approx. 10 meters of track in the carriageway to install and joint cable works to be carried out by Electricity North West.
